## *Pastor's Note...*

Each of us needs what the Spirit gives. In fact, none of us can live without it. No Christian can be a Christian without the Holy Spirit.

Why? Because the content of our character as a Christian is given and formed by the Holy Spirit. To what character traits are we pointing? Read Isaiah 11: 2.

The anointing of Jesus must fall on us in a real way just as the Spirit came to the first disciples on the day of Pentecost. Without the Holy Spirit our flesh, our human nature will reject what God works to promote and proclaim. Without the Holy Spirit we will fall for the lies of the devil and the world and then take great pains to keep them going.

The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD and he will delight in the fear of the LORD.

We will exchange the truth of God for a lie instead of the other way around without the Holy Spirit. So, what are we to do?

1. Return to the Shepherd and Overseer of your soul in repentance.
2. Trust the Lord and what He says. Don't "judge by what you see with your eyes, or decide by what you hear with your ears, but with righteousness." (Isaiah 11: 3 – 4)
3. In all your ways, acknowledge Jesus and live through Him, not as an ideal but as an individual speaking and acting in real time.
4. Ask to be baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit, then wait to act based on the Spirit's presence in your life.
5. Don't quench the Spirit or despise God's revelation.
6. Finally, don't be shy in the Spirit but discipline yourself to walk with God.

Every one of us needs the Holy Spirit. The Virginia Annual Conference needs the Holy Spirit. Memorial United Methodist Church needs the Holy Spirit.

Decide today – I won't do anything apart from the Spirit of God.

Sue Eggleston called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Leeann Robinson led devotions...Ruth Graham, "Remember Your Position" from Psalm 86.

Minutes from April 2022 were approved.

Sue Waddell (Missions)...took food to Mac's Kitchen. Will have a food drive the 4th Sunday of each month.

Bobby Waddell (SPRC)...recommended hiring a part-time administrative assistant starting June 1st. The committee will also take a look at job descriptions for these positions and update.

Kinckle Robinson (Finance)...approved recommendations from SPRC. As of 5/8, the church has taken in \$14,000 above spending plan needs.

Cindy Ranson and Angie Dillon (Daycare)...graduation was held on 5/17. APS kindergarten teachers came and tested the MDC kids and were very impressed! More work will be done on playground with covid funds.

Debby Long and Marie Milton (Congregational Care)...delivered 2 more cheer boxes, and recognized youngest mother on Mother's Day.

Nathan and Brenda Putney (Prayer)...continuing bi-weekly prayer services at 7 pm Monday evenings. Prayer ushers are meeting in the parlor on Sundays at 9 am to pray for our pastor and the service....all are welcome to join us.

Harry White (P & G)...shade sails installed, several small repairs made in Legacy Hall, water fountain in original building upstairs has been replaced, and working on plans to have church members adopt flower beds around the church. Epitome Networks installed a new communications cable in daycare to help with wi-fi, of which council agreed to split the cost.

Blair Smith (Worship)...will recognize graduates Sunday 5/22. Results of the worship survey are back, with 81% voting for 1 service, and the majority voting for 9:30 service with SS after. Planning is being done on the revival events in September.

## God can use your pain to help others struggling

Have you ever heard ... God never wastes a hurt?

Do you believe it?

Think about the significant pain and trials people in the Bible endured and how God used them.

Noah - endured the ridicule of all of his neighbors.

Joseph - sold into slavery by his brothers, wrongly accused, and imprisoned by Potiphar.

Job - children killed, lost all his wealth, covered with open sores, left to live in dust.

Moses - endured complaints and disobedience from the very people he risked his life to free

David - spent much of his life running in fear of losing his life.

Ruth - lost her husband, brothers, and father-in-law, left to work in the fields in a foreign land.

Mary - watched her firstborn son brutally executed.

Paul - faced persecution, flogging, prison, shipwreck, and dangers we could never fathom.

All the disciples except John were killed in some horrible way.



Theologian AW Tozer is quoted, "It is doubtful whether God can bless a man greatly until he is hurt deeply." Tozer's thought is similar to Job 36:15; hard times and trouble are God's way of getting our attention!

Yes, there is an encouraging thought buried here. If you're going through pain, God has a plan. This is a complex concept to wrap our arms around, but let's look at a few more recent examples of people who used their great hurt to help others.

Corrie Ten Boom's last words were, "God will give us the love to be able to forgive our enemies. There is no pit so deep that God's love is not deeper still." She used her hurt from losing her family in a Nazi prison to witness God's love to the world.

Viktor Frankl, out of the horrors of Auschwitz, wrote *Man's Meaning of Life* and presented that individuals can endure and overcome suffering.

Merline Carothers wrote *Prison to Praise*, using his experiences to help us see the benefit of praising the Lord in all things.

Horatio Spafford, as he sailed past the spot where his daughters drowned, wrote, "When sorrows like sea billows roll, whatever my lot, thou hast taught me to say It is well, it is well, with my soul."

Many great songs speak to us out of the composer's pain.

So what is your hurt? How are you using your hurt? Saint Francis of Assisi tells us, "for it is in giving that we receive." Join us Tuesday nights; your hurt could be just what is needed to help your neighbor. Call us if you have any questions.

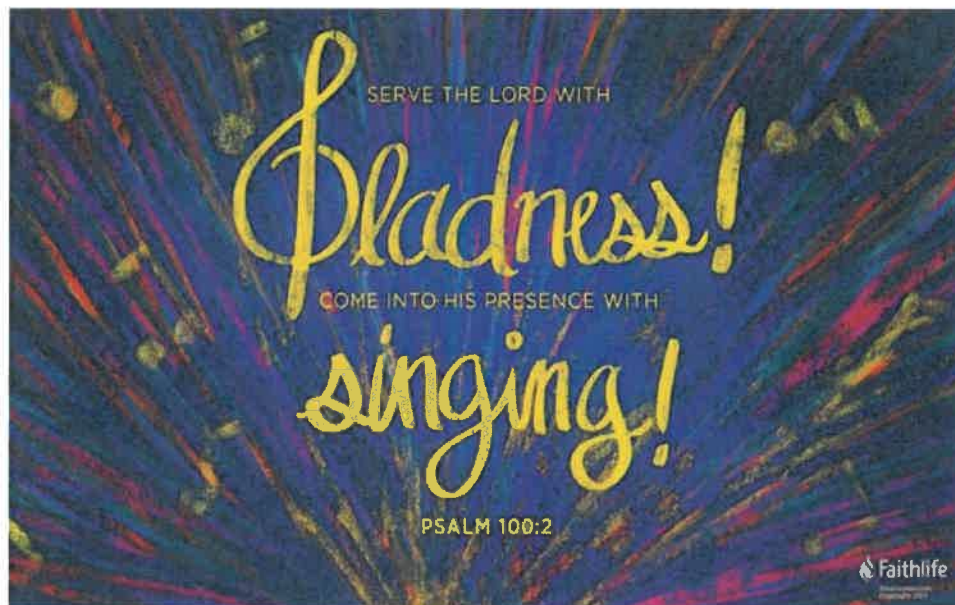

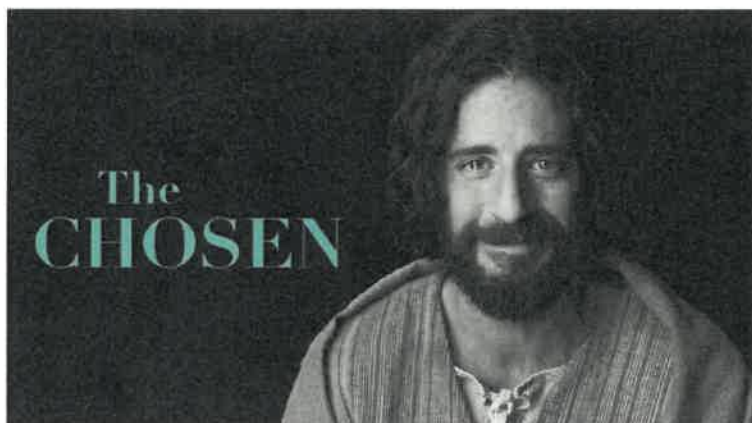
The Chosen is the largest crowd-funded media project of all time!

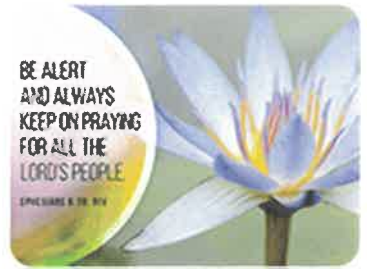

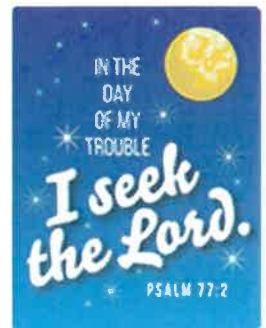
